

How to identify and enter COPD questionnaire results

This article is for ambulatory clinical staff.

What is the COPD questionnaire?

A COPD questionnaire is available in MyChart 7 days prior to an upcoming appointment if the patient meets the following criteria:

- Has an active MyChart account.
- Has an upcoming appointment in a family medicine or internal medicine department.
- Has an active COPD-related diagnosis on their problem list.

What are patients asked in the questionnaire?

A single question is displayed to patients in MyChart:

Please describe the breathlessness you experience

☒ I only get breathless with strenuous exercise

☐ I get short of breath when hurrying on level ground or walking up a slight hill

☐ On level ground, I walk slower than people of the same age because of breathlessness, or have to stop for breath when walking at my own pace

☐ I stop for breath after walking about 100 yards or after a few minutes on level ground

☐ I am too breathless to leave the house or I am breathless when dressing

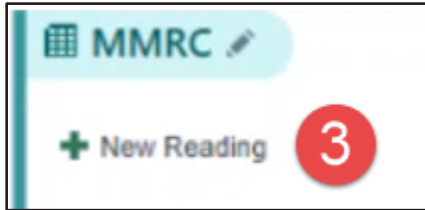

1. Navigate to the Screenings activity.
2. Scroll down to MMRC.
3. Click **New Reading**.



4. Select the breathlessness description from the list.
5. Click **Close**.
